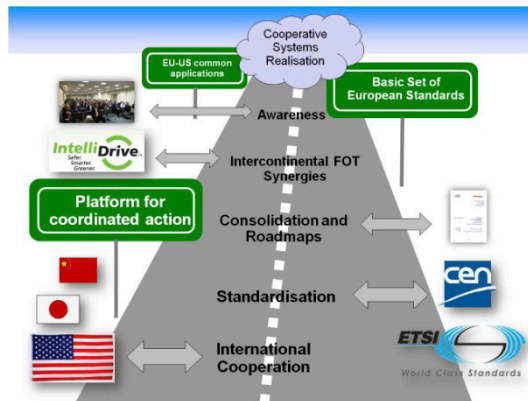
- European set of standards to support European Community wide implementation and deployment of Co-operative Intelligent Transport Systems,
